

International Relations (IR) Major

To obtain a diploma with an IR major, students must earn the required credits and develop the following competencies:

1. The ability to understand the diverse values and beliefs that make up international society, discover problems independently, get to the roots of problems, and take action from a global perspective.
2. The ability to see the problems facing the world in the contexts of one's own life and social environment, think of possible solutions, and apply them.
3. The ability to understand the role of the media and, from an international viewpoint, interpret the substance, cultural underpinnings, and ideological background of the information that media sources disseminate.
4. The ability to absorb information critically and make one's voice heard internationally.
5. The ability to communicate and express one's opinion in English and other foreign languages.
6. The ability to integrate the things one learns inside and outside the classroom, form organic bonds between theory and practice, and contribute to society in a proactive way.
