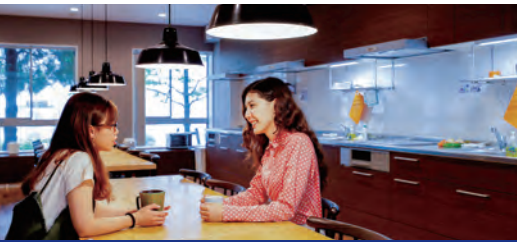

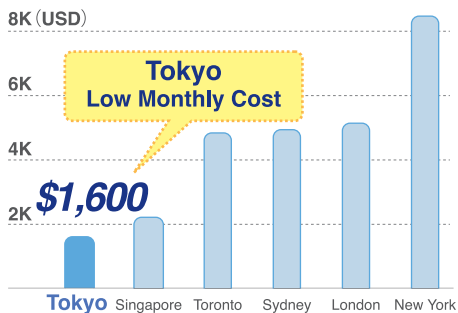

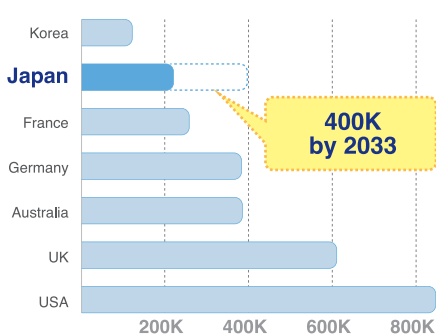

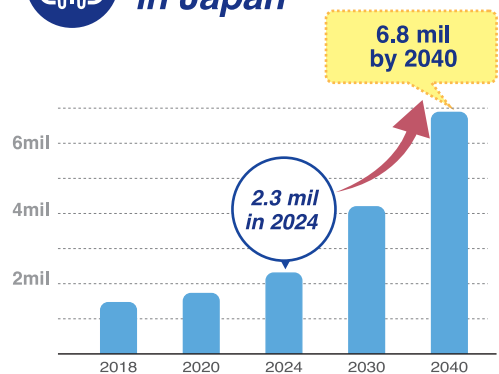
## International Students in Japan

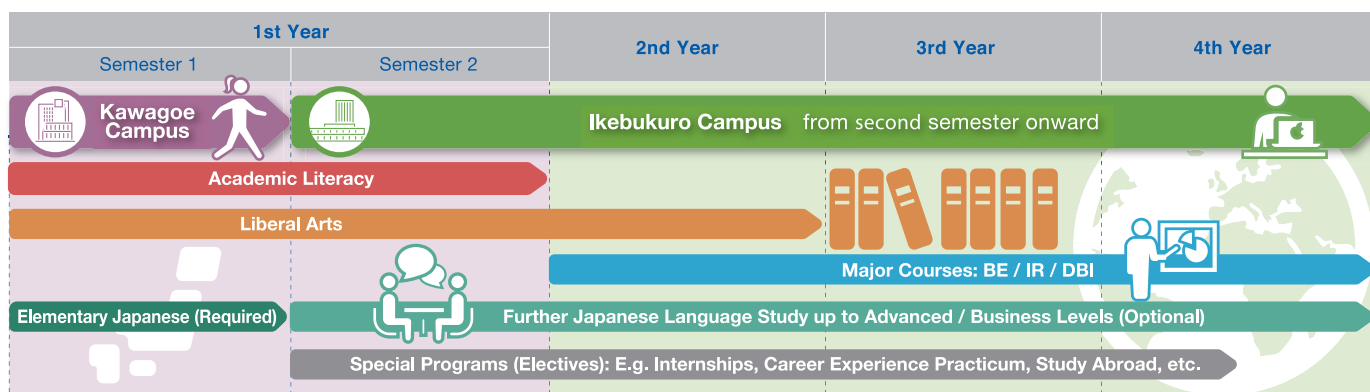

## Four-Year Academic Flow

E-Track is a multi-campus program. In the first semester, classes are held at the Kawagoe Campus in Greater Tokyo. From the second semester onward, classes will be taken at the Ikebukuro Campus in central Tokyo. The two campuses are easily connected by a fast and convenient train line. Students typically begin the program with courses in Liberal Arts, Academic Literacy, and Japanese, before moving on to courses in their chosen major. Elective courses are also available from other majors, giving students the chance to expand their academic interests and knowledge. Activities such as clubs, internships, and study abroad are highly encouraged.

- 3 Pay the application fee (5,000 yen) and apply.
- 4 Email digital copies of your documents in advance to <etrack-admissions@tiu.ac.jp>.
- 5 Send certified true copies of physical documents to arrive by each deadline.
- 6 Pay enrollment fee and other fees by each deadline.
- 7 Apply for your COE and visa by each deadline.
- 8 Depart for Japan!

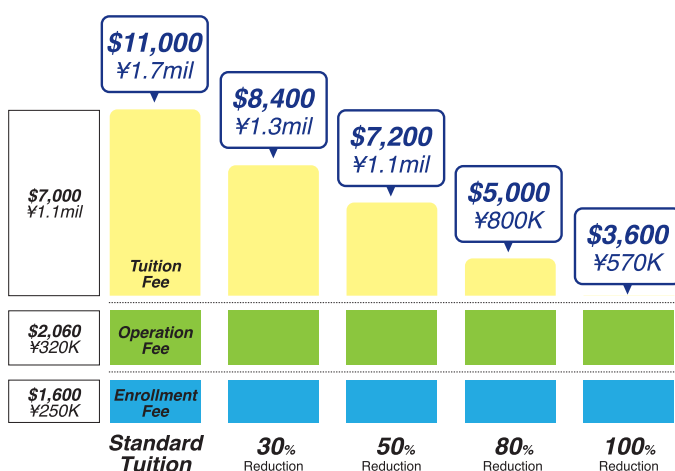

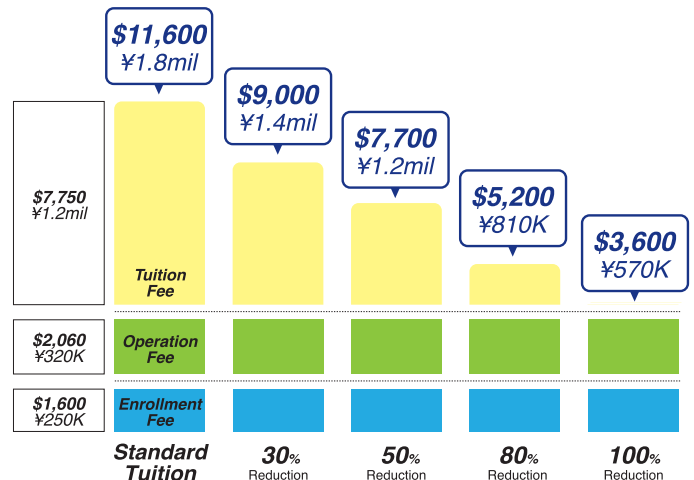
## Scholarships and Fees (for the First Year)

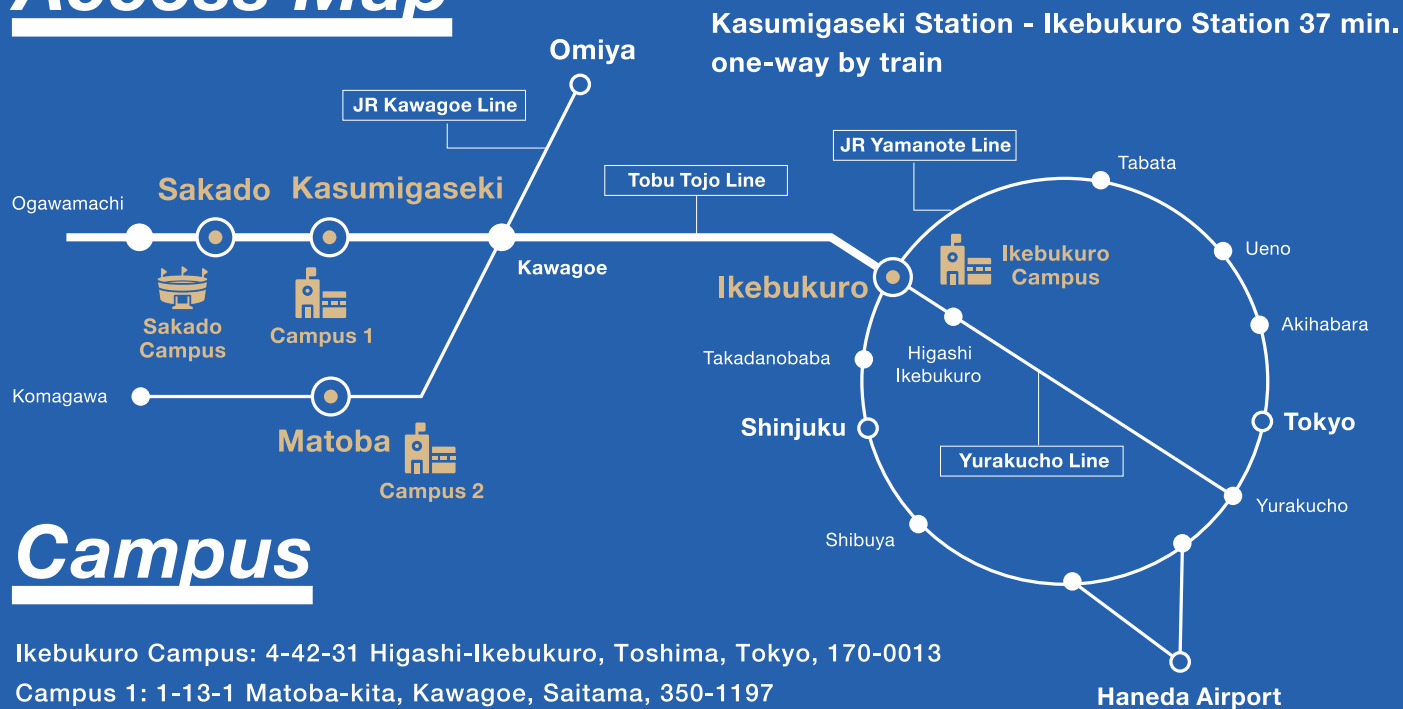
